By registering your email and other basic information on D-Net, you will receive information via email about important district issues, upcoming events, special projects or initiatives, and good news about our students and schools.

D-Net is designed to provide another way for the district to communicate on issues and events that have impact on our Davenport Schools family: News about the great work our students are doing, updates on curriculum and new learning initiatives, causes for celebration, background on important decisions, and opportunities to learn more about a wide variety of education-related topics. To register for D-Net, simply click on the link below which will take you to the registration screen where we ask for your email address and answers to a few other questions that will help us better determine the type of information to send you.

Although timely and convenient, D-Net is NOT a daily newsletter or a mechanism for emergency messages or personalized information about your student. Communication will be regular, but not constant, and you can ‘opt out’ of the program at any time.
