## **6:08 PM EXPULSION OF STUDENT CASE #9921**

Director Low stated after the Board's consideration of the evidence presented in the matter of the recommendation to expel Student Case #9921 the Board adopts the findings of fact set out in the Administrative Advisory Council, and the Board concludes the student violated the regulations and rules established by the Board and the continued presence of the pupil is detrimental to the best interest of the school:

**MOTION:** Director Low moved that after the Board's consideration of the evidence presented in the matter of the recommendation to expel Student Case #9921:

1. that Student Case #9921 be expelled from the Davenport Community School District for the remainder of the 1999-2000 school year;
2. that Student Case #9921 will not be allowed on any Davenport Community School District property or be in attendance at any school event where a Davenport team is participating during the time of the expulsion other than the site of the alternative programming;
3. that Student Case #9921 will receive services at Home Instruction/Harrison Street Program for the remainder of the 1999-2000 school year;
4. that Student Case #9921 meet with the Administrative Advisory Council prior to the beginning of the 2000-2001 school year to determine appropriate placement.

Director Hester seconded the motion.

The vote on the motion was called and recorded as follows: Ayes, Low, Hester, Howard, and Imming. Motion carried unanimously.

## EXPULSION OF STUDENT CASE #9922

Director Howard stated after the Board's consideration of the evidence presented in the matter of the recommendation to expel Student Case #9922 the Board adopts the findings of fact set out in the Administrative Advisory Council, and the Board concludes the student violated the regulations and rules established by the Board and the continued presence of the pupil is detrimental to the best interest of the school:

**MOTION:** Director Howard moved that after the Board's consideration of the evidence presented in the matter of the recommendation to expel Student Case #9922:

1. that Student Case #9922 be expelled from the Davenport Community School District for the remainder of the 1999-2000 school year;
2. that Student Case #9922 will not be allowed on any Davenport Community School District property or be in attendance at any school event where a Davenport team is participating during the time of the expulsion other than the site of the alternative programming;
3. that Student Case #9922 will receive alternative educational services for elementary aged students at the Kimberly Alternative Education Center for the remainder of the 1999-2000 school year;
4. that Student Case #9922 meet with the Administrative Advisory Council prior to the beginning of the 2000-2001 school year to determine appropriate placement.

Director Hester seconded the motion.

The vote on the motion was called and recorded as follows: Ayes, Howard, Hester, and Imming. Nay, Low. Motion carried.
