

Common Course Syllabi for DCSD Intermediate Choir & General Music

6th grade General Music

General music instruction will include basic skills for music reading and writing and music appreciation. Aspects of music to be studied will include basic music theory, music history, music of various cultures, composers, and performance skills. Performance opportunities may be offered at individual schools.

7th Grade General Music

General Music instruction will continue to develop music reading and writing skills while increasing the scope of music appreciation. Performance opportunities may be offered at individual schools.

7th Grade Choir

The student will study music reading and writing, as well as vocal music performance, enhanced by the study of the voice, proper vocal techniques, and ensemble singing. Concert attendance is required. Enrichment performance opportunities may be offered at individual schools.

8th Grade General Music

General music instruction will continue in the study of music theory and the appreciation of music from different eras, local history, cultures, and composers. Students will create a culminating project for each unit.

8th Grade Choir

The student will build on their musical skills and vocal technique. Repertoire selected for this ensemble reflects advanced literature. Concert attendance is required. Enrichment performance opportunities may be offered at individual schools.
